- **Therapy:** Work with a Master's level therapist, exploring the woman's path to addiction and recovery
- **Weekly Support Group:** **AWARE** group gives opportunity to
 - Foster peer relations
 - Learn coping skills and recovery tools
 - Explore issues unique to women
- **Referrals and Advocacy:** We collaborate with community agencies and act on behalf of women involved with Child Protective Services
