### CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTER

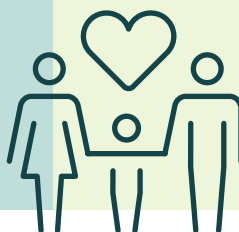
The Children's Advocacy Center of Kalamazoo is a caring, child-focused, safe place for children who have been sexually or severely physically abused. Our services include forensic interviews, follow-up contact, criminal/civil justice system assistance, crisis hotline assistance, mental health intake appointments, crime victims' rights assistance, CPS referrals, medical referrals, and personal advocacy.

## PREVENTION SERVICES

### S.T.R.E.E.T. AFTER SCHOOL & SUMMER PROGRAM

S.T.R.E.E.T. provides after school and summer services for Black male youth ages 10-17 who live in Kalamazoo and are experiencing academic, social, or emotional delays, or who experience behavioral/mental health problems as a reflection of vulnerabilities in the communities in which they live. The program is structured to eliminate racial barriers and stigmas that have a negative influence, as well as decrease underage drinking and drug use among adolescents.

### NIÑAS DEL CORAZÓN (GIRLS OF THE HEART)

Niñas del Corazón provides after school and summer services for Latina youth ages 8 – 15 who live in Kalamazoo. We address low academic performance, underage drinking and drug use, acculturation trauma awareness, and social emotional skills development.
