Here's how it works:

- Players or teams are divided into pools or groups (based on the number of registrants).
- Everyone in the group plays each other once.
- Matches are typically timed or played to a set number of points (e.g., first to 11 or 15).
- At the end of the round robin, scores or wins are tallied to determine overall standings.
- If there's time, top teams or individuals may advance to a championship or playoff round.
