Our population has been detoured in life due to Social Justice Inequities such as Substance Use Disorders, Incarceration, Homelessness, and Discrimination.

WHY H.O.P.E.

Founded in 2015 in response to an ever increasing number of disenfranchised individuals and families falling thru the cracks of Kalamazoo County due to not being able to navigate the very systems designed to help them. Founded by Gwendolyn Hooker, an impassioned community advocate, motivated by her lifelong pursuit of self-sufficiency and equality for everyone Ms. Hooker set out to empower and strengthen the community that she loves and adores.

RESEARCH

In researching issues that directly impact the identified demographic (Homeless Adults with Criminal Background and or Substance Use Disorder) and their measure of success the 2 most notable contributors to long-term successful outcomes are:

- 1. Housing
- 2. Employment

These 2 factors are the highest contributors and account for over 87% success rate in adults with a Criminal Background and or Substance Use Disorder. In other words if we provide housing and employment within the first 30 - 45 days of re-entry the likelihood of repeat offenses (recidivism) and or relapse are lowered by 72%. (SMART Justice).




